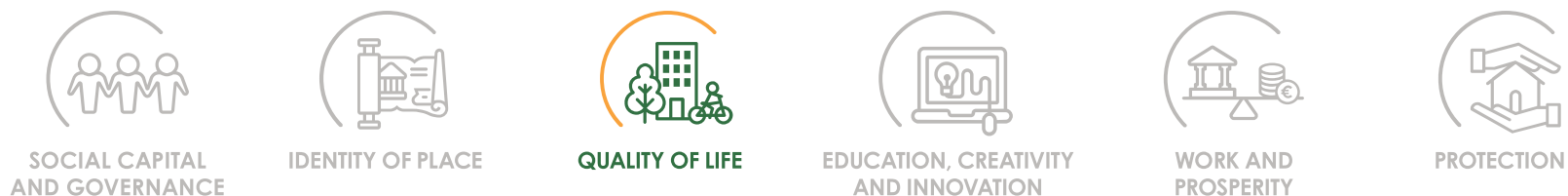








SOPHIA HOLISTIC HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT MODEL



SUBTHEMES	ISSUES AND INDICATORS			
	Quantitative indicators ↓	People's perspective ↓	Cross-cutting issues with other themes ↓	Counter-effects on other themes ↓
 LIVING CONDITIONS	Assess whether the cultural heritage intervention contributes positively towards living conditions for the people living, working or staying in the surrounding neighbourhoods.			
 PEACE AND SAFETY	Assess whether the intervention promotes and ensures peace building, personal safety, and security of community.			
 SOCIAL LIFE	Assess whether participation of community groups and civic engagement is encouraged.			
 ENVIRONMENT	Assess whether the intervention provides recreational opportunities while also maintaining the integrity of the intervention/heritage.			
 REGIONAL AND LOCAL DEVELOPMENT	Assess whether the intervention promotes the regional/local development through cultural investments.

 LIVING CONDITIONS	Numbers of people living, working and socialising in the area (in order to measure change/development /variation) ...	What are the objectives of the intervention in terms of living conditions for residents and people working in the area? ...	Identity of place; Work & Prosperity and Social Capital & Governance; Education, Creativity & Innovation.	Identity of Place and Protection; Quality of Life; Work & Prosperity and Identity of Place.
