SUBTHEMES	ISSUES AND INDICATORS			
	Quantitative indicators ↓	People's perspective ↓	Cross-cutting issues with other themes ↓	Counter-effects on other themes ↓
 EMPLOYMENT	Assess the quantity and quality of employment related directly to the intervention/site or indirectly/induced in the context.			
 LOCAL CULTURAL PRODUCTION	Assess whether the intervention promotes local cultural production.			
 TOURISM ECONOMY	Assess the quantity and quality of the surrounding tourism economy.			
 ECONOMIC ATTRACTIVENESS	Assess whether the intervention attracts further economic flows, generating a multiplier effect and attracts investments/funding through the cooperation between the private, public and third sectors..			
 SOCIAL INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP	Assess the innovation in terms of social change and growth.
